Internet Starts with the Browser

Our life consists of many choices such as what to wear, what to eat for breakfast, where to learn etc. But we often neglect the choice of things we use every day such as the Internet browser. To find a safe and easy-to-use browser I compared the characteristics of the four most popular browsers and made certain conclusions. So, in the centre of our attention are Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, Opera and Mozilla Firefox.

Google Chrome has a high level of reliability and security: each tab is executed separately. Built-in mechanisms monitor potentially dangerous content and when you try to load such pages the browser will notify you. It provides access to several dozens of services almost instantly, without installing extensions. It cannot boast a nice interface, but it is, perhaps, the only slight disadvantage. It is also worth saying that Google Chrome memory consumes a little more than other browsers.

Internet Explorer puts emphasis on the counteraction to XSS attacks, view in private mode and tracking protection function. The second level domain is selected in the address bar of the browser, bold in color that allows you to determine easily whether a user is on the real site or on a "spoofed" one, which address is similar to the address of this site. The most important advantage is the operating system. Unfortunately, it's only one, as it has low speed and bad protection.

Opera is one of the fastest browsers and it is quite well protected from the attempts of passing to the potentially dangerous page and harmful software. Users with a low-speed communication channel will estimate the ability of the built-in advertisement blocking, and also the Turbo mode. The defects are: a file type is not always correctly recognized by the link, it saves the copies of web pages on the hard disk inaccurately.

Mozilla Firefox features the ability of expansion and adjusting for any needs due to the big amount of expansions. But, an ordinary user finds it difficult to find a reasonable set in the abundance of the additional modules. It is not always comfortable to use the browser without settings; also not all expansions are written correctly, that results in errors. This browser is suitable for advanced users.

Perhaps, it is enough to understand the features of each browser in general. I have already been using Google Chrome for about two years, I am absolutely satisfied with everything, but everyone should choose the most suitable browser for himself or herself. A very interesting fact that Google Chrome is the most popular browser in Ukraine, as well as in Russia and Internet Explorer is moved to the last position and is in poor request. On the other hand in the world rating of browsers popularity Internet Explorer gains a lead.
